# New Exhibit Opens at Parachute Museum

### Joint Precision Air Drop System (JPADS)



The Aviation Trail Parachute Museum has introduced a new exhibit as of August, 2022. On display is a fully rigged heavy payload shown as it would be prepared for an airdrop using the Joint Precision Air Drop System.

The Joint Precision Air Drop system (JPADS) is an American military air drop system which uses the Global Positioning System (GPS), steerable parachutes, and an onboard computer to steer loads to a designated point of impact (PI) on a drop zone (DZ). The JPADS family of systems, ranging from extra light to heavy loads. JPADS is used in conjunction with mission planning software that resides on a laptop. The function of this mission software included computing releaste points, weather forecasting, acquiring measurements of wind velocity, altitude, air pressure and temperature. It can also receive weather updates and in route mission changes through satellite






#### 2K Screamer

One of the many JPADS systems tested, and the first to be used operationally, was the 2K Screamer system for loads from 500-2200 pounds. The 2K Screamer initially flies under a small 220 sq.ft. ram air drogue to glide to the target then just before

touchdown deploys a larger 56 ft. diameter round parachute for safely landing. See the diagram on the next frame.



# RTCA and NAHF Launch New Scholarship Program

RTCA powers professional development for Discovering Flight with the National Aviation Hall of Fame



The National Aviation Hall of Fame (NAHF) and RTCA, Inc. have partnered to create a new scholarship program targeted at educators teaching grades Pre-K - 6th grade.

The purpose of the scholarship program is to support educators who are sharing the concepts of aviation and aerospace with students through the curriculum portion of the NAHF's education program Discovering Flight with the NAHF. The STEM/STEAM-based, multidisciplinary curriculum, Problem Solving with Wilbur and Orville, is created by ThinkTV/PBS and is a part of a course designed to empower educators and inspire students. The ideal candidates are educators who have a special interest in enhancing their knowledge and abilities through professional development in STEM/STEAM fields and who are pursuing continuing education credits in this area. RTCA and NAHF plan to award five scholarships in the next 12 months.

"With the unmatched power of PBS, the NAHF created a program designed to enable teachers to confidently teach STEM concepts", said Amy Spowart, President and CEO of the NAHF. "The generous scholarships provided through RTCA create an opportunity to bolster educators' knowledge of STEM by providing support for additional development. We are thrilled by this partnership and what it offers educators.
